Frequently Asked Questions

What award will I be offered?

You will be undertaking a Scottish Vocational Qualification (SVQ).

Do I need to sit an exam?

No. To complete your SVQ you will need to build up a portfolio of evidence to show that you are meeting a set of standards relevant to the work you undertake as part of your caring responsibilities. Your evidence will include reflective accounts written by you on what you did in a particular situation and also statements written by the assessor who will be supporting you throughout your award.



Frequently Asked Questions/ continued

How will I know what to do?

When you start, you will be assigned an assessor who will work with you to help you complete your award. They will help you plan and complete each piece of work and be with you every step of the way.

What if I am not good at writing?

Don't worry. Your SVQ isn't based on how well you write. As long as you get the key information into your reflective accounts, then you will be fine. And your assessor will support you in getting the best out of your work.

How long will it take?

The SVQ award that you will be undertaking normally takes 6 months to complete. However, we appreciate the responsibilities you have, so we will be supporting you to complete within 12 months (but if you need a bit longer then that's okay too).

How much will the award cost?

Normally an SVQ award can cost hundreds or even thousands of pounds. However, Aberdeen Health & Social Care Partnership has allocated money to fund these awards. All we need from you is energy, enthusiasm and a willingness to succeed.
